“For the last 3 years as a faculty advocate, student advocate, treasurer, and society president”

The complainants claim that the statement is deliberately misleading voters.

After checking records on the SU website the DRO is satisfied that we have records showing them holding the following positions:

- Course Advocate- 2019-20
- Faculty Advocate- 2019-20
- Treasurer- The World Society- 2019-20
- Treasurer- Cricket (Men’s)- 2019-20
- Treasurer- Hockey (Men’s)- 2019-20
- Treasurer- Islamic Society- 2019-20

Usama’s email stated:

“I was the course advocate for my course BSc Accounting and Finance, from September 2018 onwards. I was the faculty advocate for FBL in my second year, which was 2019 onwards. I was the treasurer for men's hockey and cricket team during the same year which was September 2019 onwards. And I was the President of the Islamic Society which was formed in late 2019, I cannot remember the month as it has been long.”

The DRO is satisfied that Usama’s manifesto is an accurate record of roles he has held in the SU, and there is therefore no further action required.
